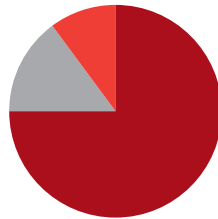

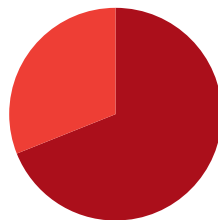

Action Strategy

Freedom 4/24 employs a "Strategic Partnerships" model to accomplish its mission worldwide. Additionally, we host a variety of awareness and fundraising events including 5K walk/runs, individual event fundraisers, and a black-tie gala to galvanize local communities to join in the fight against sexual exploitation and human trafficking. In 2017 we hosted more than 15 such events throughout the United States. Finally, Freedom 4/24 provides direct programming through its Awareness & Education (A&E) Initiative, prevention education specifically targeting domestic youth to protect them from exploitation and trafficking.

Programs

Turning awareness into action is at the core of every program

- Race events (relationship building, evangelism, awareness)
- Teaching (educational materials, lectures, and public speaking)
- General awareness (events, social media, print media)
- A&E Initiative, prevention education to local youth

Additional Activities

- Short-term awareness/mission trips (In 2017 we lead 5 international trips.)
- Internship Programs (In 2017 we had 10 interns serve in a variety of areas.)
