SUMMARY

To serve as the Videography Intern with the aim of supporting the Director of Marketing & Operations and Freedom 4/24 by creating videos to support multiple initiatives within the organization.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES include the following. Other duties may be assigned.

- 1. Work with the Director of Communications & Marketing and collaborative team to create the film or video product.
- 2. Knowledge, experience, and access to Adobe Premiere Pro or similar high-quality software.
- 3. Create script and video outline to present to supervisor.
- 4. Determine the most appropriate equipment to use and/or access to rent equipment
- 5. Set up and tear down cameras, audio recorders, lighting, microphones, and props, as well as clean and disassemble hardware.
- 6. Prepare background film or "B" rolls as well as live feed.
- 7. Troubleshoot problems with the equipment.
- 8. Create video content series involving multiple speakers on film for human trafficking curriculums
- 9. Insert closed captioning, graphics, special effects or other on-screen text into a video.
- 10. Relevant knowledge of social media video content and current trends
- 11. Sourcing past raw footage and creating short videos for social media
- 12. Other duties as assigned by the Freedom 4/24 staff.

SUPERVISORY RESPONSIBILITIES

This internship does not require any supervisory responsibilities.

QUALIFICATIONS

To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform each essential duty satisfactorily. The individual must be self motivated and have the ability to problem solve and to seek out creative solutions independently but also understand that program development requires community effort. The individual must also have his/her own access to the appropriate software for video editing.
